



3rd-6th Grade Audition Requirements
3rd-6th graders will audition in all four Fine Arts

Auditions for the 2021-2022 school year will be in an online format where students will view an instructional video and then record themselves completing the required tasks. Ensure that your student is seen clearly in the camera frame of the audition recording. For dance and theatre the entire body should be visible. Provide your student with enough room to move around freely (8 to 10 feet is recommended). You and your student should watch the full **Audition Instructional Video** from beginning to end and then record themselves performing.

Audition Attire: Students should wear clothing in which they can move easily. Dance clothes are encouraged, but not required. Students may wear their dance attire during the other portions of the audition if preferred. Costumes and props are not allowed. Long hair must be secured back. Examples of appropriate clothing include:

- Top = leotard, fitted t-shirt, or tank top
- Bottom = dance pants, tights, leggings, or fitted athletic pants
- Feet = ballet shoes, jazz shoes, or socks

Supplies Needed: Graphite pencil, 2 large sheets of drawing paper (mixed media paper or poster board can work), other art supplies that can be found around you home (examples: crayons, colored pencils, markers, paints). Items from around the house to create a still life display. A variety of simple three dimensional objects.
