This year, our challenges have never been greater. In crafting our recommended levels of giving, we have carefully analyzed the needs of our teachers, students, and community to ensure sustainability and advancement.

This year, would you consider giving at one of the following recommended levels?

### SUSTAINING GIFT

*One time gift of \$120 per student, or \$10 per month*

| These gifts directly impact students by supporting our expanded technological resources that connect them to their teachers, provides funds for wardrobes, music royalties, scripts, classroom supplies, and campus maintenance and improvements that provide a safe and healthy learning environment.

### IMPACT GIFT

*One time gift of \$300 per student, or \$25 per month*

| These gifts help us ensure our teachers have the necessary personal protective equipment for themselves and their classrooms and gives us the means to purchase technological hardware and software for student learning on and off campus.

### LEADERSHIP GIFT

*One time gift of \$900+, or \$75 per month*

| These gifts allow for us to make upgrades and improvements in technology, teaching resources and program materials on both campuses. These funds also provide the means to underwrite, advertise, and provide transportation for performances and school-related activities.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHY GIVE TO CHARTER SCHOOLS?

Charter schools, including Texas School of the Arts and Fort Worth Academy of Fine Arts, allow for focused instruction that is adaptable, flexible and caters to students needs. As you well know, our esteemed charter schools provide valuable opportunities for our students to pursue their passions in both arts and academics.

### WHAT IS THE GAP IN FUNDING?

While we receive approximately 90% of our budget from the state and federal government, we must find other sources of funding including community partnerships and individual donations to fill the gap of approximately \$1,900 per student to maintain current standards and programs.

### WHAT IS THE IMPACT OF CORONAVIRUS?

This year, COVID-19 has brought about many unexpected changes in our lives. At TCAA, we canceled our fundraising events, performances, and lost significant revenue from our conservatory and summer camp programs. Despite this lost income, we prioritized deep cleans of our campuses, supplied students in need with necessary technology to access online learning, and purchased health screening services for student and staff to use while on campus.

### HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE?

Every donation, from \$7.50 to \$750 makes a difference in the services we can provide and the student experience on campus. We ask that you give a donation that is meaningful to you. Suggested donation amounts are listed on the reverse side.

### WHAT INCENTIVES DO I HAVE TO GIVE?

While it is difficult to promise tickets and other special offers, we are confident that the students you love will see your gifts in action. Additionally, itemizers can deduct 100% of charitable gifts and non-itemizers can deduct up to \$300 from gross income this year thanks to the CARES Act.

### WHAT IF I CANNOT GIVE?

There is no tuition requirement for our schools and there is no requirement to contribute. However if you believe in the benefit of our schools and programs, and wish to contribute to the flourishing arts community, please consider making a gift that makes sense for you.
