Find the appropriate top box and follow the arrows through all of the corresponding colored boxes.

Individual tests positive

Send POSITIVE test results to tammy.smith@mytesa.org

Individual must self-isolate/quarantine until Return to School Criteria is met.

School determines if other students or staff were in "close contact" with positive-tested individual, and notifies appropriately.

Return to School Criteria

May return to School when all the following has been met:

1. At least 24 hours without fever, without fever-reducing

- medication
 2. Symptoms have improved
- 3. At least 5 days have passed since positive test results

Individual experiences one or more symptoms causing distress during the school day or before entry in the building

COVID test

(via testing facility, school

or home)

Once results are

received/known

Individual reports being, or is, determined to be in "close contact" with someone who has tested positive

Individual reports someone in their home was exposed to someone who tested positive

Return to School Criteria

For those without symptoms:

1. Individual chooses to quarantine and attend Remote Conferencing for up to 5 days to monitor for symptoms.

2. Individual chooses to return to campus as long as he/she remains symptom-free.

For those with, or soon thereafter develop, symptoms:

Follow BLUE BOXES No quarantine necessary.

Individual should come to school and continue to monitor for symptoms

Return to School Criteria

- 1. Provides Negative test results to tammy.smith@mytesa.org or
- 2. Provides Alternate Medical Diagnosis to tammy.smith@mytesa.org or
- 3. Meets Vellow Return to school criteria.



Due to the variety of COVID strains, symptoms may present in a number of ways.

Keep your student home, and email tammy.smith@mytesa.org if he/she is having ANY symptoms of concern.

Close Contact Definition:

Within 6 feet for a cumulative duration of 15 minutes or more during a 24-hour period.

COVID Testing Information:

COVID tests are viral tests. The **PCR Testing** is considered the "gold standard" for diagnosing COVID-19 because it's the most accurate and reliable test.

Home Rapid Covid tests are acceptable for students as long as the test trip has the student's NAME and test DATE documented on it.

Employee Information:

TeSA employees should consult the Principal and HR Specialist for the most up-to-date information regarding documentation and leave due to COVID-19.
