Return to School Criteria

For those **without symptoms**:

- 1. Individual chooses to quarantine and attend Remote Conferencing for up to 5 days to monitor for symptoms.
- 2. Individual chooses to return to campus as long as he/she remains symptom-free.

For those with, or soon thereafter develop, symptoms:

Follow BLUE BOXES

Due to the variety of Covid strains, symptoms may present in a number of ways (new and old symptoms). PLEASE just keep your student home if having ANY symptoms of concern that may interfere with learning.

<u>Close Contact:</u> Within 6 feet for a cumulative duration of 15 minutes or more during a 24-hour period.

<u>Covid tests</u> are VIRAL tests. The PCR test is the "gold standard" for diagnosing COVID-19 because it's the most accurate and reliable test.

Home Rapid Covid tests are acceptable for students as long as the test trip has the student's NAME and test DATE documented on it.

*Facility testing (not home testing) is <u>required for staff</u> unless Rapid tested by NurseKay

Return to School Criteria

May return to School when all the following has been met:

- 1. At least 24 hrs. without fever (without fever reducing medication).
- 2. Symptoms have improved.
- 3. At least 5 days have passed since positive test results.
- 4. Recommend wearing mask for 5 days upon returning
 --No additional testing

required--

Return to School Criteria

1. Provides Negative Covid test

or

2. Provides Alternate Medical Diagnosis

or

3. Meets Yellow Return to school criteria.

Any student returning to school following Covid related issues, MUST see Nurse BEFORE first class for Clearance Pass.
