

Fort Worth Academy of Fine Arts (FWAFA) 2023-2024 Audition Workshops Schedule & Information

December 10, 2022 & January 14, 2023

Purpose: The audition workshop is designed to help students know what to expect and feel better prepared for their actual audition(s). We encourage parents to attend this mock audition experience with their student. This gives parents the knowledge they need to help their student continue to prepare after the workshop. ****On the actual audition day, parents are NOT allowed in with their student.****

Location: Both audition workshops will be held on the FWAFA campus and utilize similar rooms to the ones that the actual audition will be held in.

Who Runs the Audition Workshop: Each practice, or mock audition, is led by a current FWAFA high school student who is active in that specific department. Paula Fukuhara, the Fine Arts Administrative Coordinator, will be onsite to answer any additional questions students or parents may have.

This lets us know to expect you and allows us to anticipate group size.

Who Should/Can Attend: All students interested in auditioning for FWAFA for the 2023-2024 school year should attend. Due to limited space, we only allow 1 adult to attend with each student. If you have multiple students auditioning, please try to bring 1 adult per child so you can split up and follow the schedule for each child's correct grade level.

Which One Should We Attend: Both Audition Workshops (Dec. 10 & Jan. 14) are exactly the same. You can attend whichever one works best for your schedule. You do not need to attend both and we ask that you please only attend once. The benefit of attending the first one, if you are able, is to have more time to use the information you learned to prepare for your audition.

Are We Required to Attend: No, our Audition Workshops are a tool we offer to help students prepare but are not required.

What Should the Student Wear: Please wear comfortable clothes that you can easily move in. Both dance and theatre auditions require movement. All participants, students and parents, are required to remove their street shoes when they enter the studio for the dance portion.

What Should We Bring: Bring your excitement to learn about our process. Please do not bring artwork, monologue scripts, music, etc. with you. We provide all needed materials for the workshop.

Do We Need to Stay All Day: No, you only need to stay for the grade and arts area your student plans to audition for.

For example:

- If your student is auditioning for 6th grade for the 2023-2024 school year in dance and theatre, then those are the only 2 sections you need to attend.
- If your student is auditioning for 3rd grade for the 2023-2024 school year and they are undecided in what 2 areas they want to audition, you are welcome to attend all 4 sections for 3rd grade.
- There is only one time available for high school students since they only audition in one area. All four arts areas are available during that time and students can attend the one they plan to audition in.

What is the Schedule: Listed below is the grade your child is auditioning for in the 2023-2024 school year (not the grade they are currently in). This schedule is the same for both December 10 and January 14.
