

# What:

School Supplies = \$125 per student.

- K-2nd = \$120 to Homeroom, \$5 to Fine Arts
- 3rd-5th = \$110 to Homeroom, \$15 to Fine Arts

### How:

- Make a one-time payment.
- OR divide the cost into two equal payments.
- OR cash or check may be dropped off at the TeSA front office.

# Why:

### Teacher Perspective:

In order to maintain the most equity possible and ensure all students have access to the same supplies in the classroom, homeroom teachers use the collected school supply funds to purchase all classroom supplies in bulk. Each classroom will be slightly different, as teachers may color code items, purchase content-specific materials, and/or make personalized supplies for their homeroom.

#### Parent Perspective:
