Tuition and Fees

Registration Fees

- If you register **before August 14, 2026** the **registration fee is WAIVED!**
- Individual student: \$35/student
- Two or more students **in the same family/household**: \$65/family

Dates and Tuition Information

- Classes begin on **August 17, 2026**, but you don't pay until **September 1, 2026**
- Classes end after Spring recitals or showings.
- Each class occurs 15-18 times per semester and 31-35 times in the year.
- Monthly tuition rates for group classes equal **less than \$20/class**.

Tuition Schedule and Policies

- Tuition will be posted in the parent portal on the 25th of each month for the following month (ie, Tuition for September is posted on August 25th).
- Tuition is collected September through May.
- Tuition payment will be automatically collected on the 1st of each month.
- If we are unable to collect, we will contact you to update your billing method.
- Any unpaid tuition after the **15th of each month** will incur a **\$15 late fee**.
- Students with tuition that is **30 days late or more** will be **unenrolled** from the class.
- **Tuition fees are nonrefundable.**

Weekly Group Classes Tuition Rates

- \$60/month/class
- 5% discount when paying for a full semester (\$256.50/semester/class)
- 10% discount when paying for a full year (\$486/class)

Ongoing Private Lessons Tuition Rates

- 30 minutes every week: \$160/month
- 45 minutes every week: \$220/month
- 60 minutes every week: \$280/month

One-Off Private Lesson Tuition Rates

One-off private lessons must be scheduled and paid for in advance. Please email conservatories@artsacademics.org to schedule.

- 30 minute lesson: \$40/lesson
- 45 minute lesson: \$55/lesson
- 60 minute lesson: \$70/lesson

Clothing and Hair

- Option 1: leotard and tights
- Option 2: leggings and a fitted athletic top
- Option 3: ankle length unitard or bodysuit
- Long hair should be pulled away from the face

Please Do NOT Wear

- jewelry
- crop tops/bra tops
- exposed midriff
- exposed undergarments
- shorts
- t-shirts
- baggy clothing

Shoes

- Ballet shoes for ballet class.
- Jazz shoes for jazz dance class.
- Students will be barefoot in Contemporary Class and in Dance FUNdamentals.
- **If a student has been approved for pointe shoes**, they should bring those to Ballet and Pointe Class.
- **Do NOT purchase pointe shoes without approval from the instructor and setting up a time to be fitted.**
